WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

(hereinafter referred as "Company" which expression shall, unless repugnant or inconsistent to the subject or the context thereof, mean and included its Subsidiaries, Group Companies, Holding Companies, Sister Concern, Affiliates, successors and permitted assigns) is the sole and exclusive owner of the website <u>www.integrari.com (hereinafter referred to as "website"</u>) is exclusively owned, operated & controlled by the Company.

1. Our Commitment to Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. To better protect your privacy we provide this notice explaining our online information practices and the choices you can make about the way your information is collected and used. This Privacy Policy explains briefly the manner your data is collected and used by the Company on the website. 2. Types of Information Collected

We retain two types of information:

"Company and Personal Data"

5. Sale of Business
